

And when the host ran out of wine, Mary convinced Jesus to make more wine, some 120 to 180 gallons, which was much better than the first wine served. This was the first of Jesus' miracles, the first of countless miracles he performed while he walked this earth as one of us.

God sent his only Son, Jesus, to become one of us. Jesus was flesh and bones, eating and sleeping, walking and talking, a real person, loving and hurting. He laughed and he cried, just like we do, he went to the wedding party, just like we do... And then he died for us, and took all our sins with him to the grave....!!!
